**Job Summary:**

The role of the Disassembly Technician is to support the efforts of NWFB - Spring Back Mattress Recycling (SB) by processing recyclable mattresses and box springs into their respective materials

**Duties/Responsibilities:**

- Accomplishes warehouse objectives by participating in training, follow instruction, being flexible and following directions
- Exhibits professionalism in personal appearance and willingness to interact with NW Furniture Bank, Hope Furnishings and Commercial Clients such as hotels, universities, etc. to meet overall SB objective
- Maintains warehouse and personal work area by organizing and cleaning
- Takes initiative and ownership of warehouse duties in order to meet minimum daily goal of 40-60 mattresses and box springs processed
- Ability to operate heavy equipment such as forklifts, balers, box spring scraper etc. when applicable
- Embodies team with willingness to grow, be flexible, communicate clearly, be calm under pressure, and has ability to follow through on written or verbal instruction
